Problem Sessions (1½-2 hours/week, as scheduled)
$\rightarrow$ Problem Sessions are an essential part of this course. Problem Sessions and homework count for $40 \%$ of the grade.
$\rightarrow$ Problem Sessions are an "audience participation" event. YOU TEACH EACH OTHER, with comments from the instructor.
$\rightarrow$ The instructor will be available for 30-45 minutes after the problem session to answer questions individually or in small groups.
$\rightarrow$ You are expected to present, discuss and elucidate solutions to the homework in the problem session.
$\rightarrow$ Selected students-generally $4-5$ per set-will be tasked, in advance, to present in the upcoming problem session. Part of the job of presenters is to prepare a set of solutions, for posting.
N.B. Students who present a given set will need to be prepared before the official due date for that set.
